**Workshop(s)**  
 1 Workshop = 2 pts  
 (Max = 16 pts in 4 years)

**Tests**  
 2 different and non-repeated tests per year  
 (Max = 4 pts per year)  
 Such as PSAT, SAT, ACT, etc.

**Community Service**  
 5 hours = 1 pt  
 (5 hours to WCST, effective 2007-2008)  
 (Max = 5 pts per year = 25 hrs.)



**Grade Points**  
 A = 3 points  
 B = 2 points  
 C = 1 point  
 D = 0 points  
 F = 0 points

**Attendance per Year**  
 0 Absences = 4 pts  
 1-3 Absences = 3 pts  
 4-5 Absences = 2 pts  
 6+ Absences = 0 pts

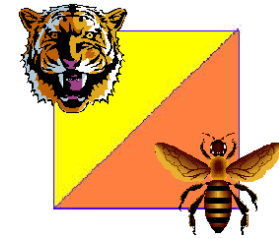

## WCST Facts

- Any graduate of Chipley High School or Vernon High School since school year 1999-2000 is eligible to receive Scholarship Trust funds if the student participated while enrolled as a student.
- Only credits awarded by Chipley High School and Vernon High School are accepted.
- Regular school year credits must be awarded for new (not repeated) courses.
- Regular school year documents with a copy of the appropriate report card must be postmarked on or before June 15th of each year.
- Community service points will NOT be awarded for community service receiving high school credit.
- Community service documents must be postmarked on or before June 15th of each year.
- Standardized test scores can only be reported **one** time per test (does not include FCAT). A copy of the test results must be attached to the End of the Year Point Schedule.
- Students may participate one, two, three, and/or four years of high school in Washington County.
- Military service is considered an occupation.
- Students and parents are solely re-

- sponsible for acquiring, completing, and filing all documents to the given address.
- All documents are available from the guidance counselor at Chipley High School or Vernon High School, or can be requested at the address on the front.
- Final documentation of enrollment at a post-secondary institution **must** be a letter from the institution's registrar's office. Copies of a student's schedule is **not** sufficient.
- The awarding of Trust funds will be based on the total number of points acquired at Chipley High School or Vernon High School in grades 9-12 and final documentation.
- The maximum number of points that can be acquired in a regular school year is 53.

Grades	36 points
Attendance	4 points
Workshops	4 points
Community Service	5 points
Standardized Tests (not FCAT)	4 points
- Only one elective course will be awarded points per school year.
- A student/parent cannot add, delete, or change any information from a previous school year.
- An appointed committee reviews all documentation received.
- All documents must be **postmarked on or before June 15th of each year.**
