FACT SHEET

- Any graduate of Chipley High School or Vernon High School since school year 1999-2000 is eligible to receive Scholarship Trust funds if the student participated while enrolled as a student.
- Only credits awarded by Chipley High School and Vernon High School are accepted.
- Summer school credits must be awarded from new (not repeated) courses.
- Summer school documents must be filed on or before June 15th of each year.
- Regular school year credits must be awarded for new (not repeated) courses.
- Regular school year documents with a copy of the appropriate report card must be filed on or before June 15th of each year.
- Community Service points will NOT be awarded for community service receiving high school credit.
- Community Service documents must be filed on or before June 15th of each year.
- Test scores can only be reported **one** time per test. A copy of the test results must be attached to the End of the Year Point Schedule.
- Five hours of Community Service hours will be dedicated to WCST by time or other activities sponsored by WCST (effective 2007-2008 school year).
- Standardized test scores can only be reported **one** time per test (does not include FCAT). A copy of the test results must be attached to the End of the Year Point Schedule.
- Students may participate one, two, three, and/or four years of high school in Washington County.
- Students and parents are solely responsible for acquiring, completing, and filing all documents to the address above.
- Military service is considered an occupation.

- All documents are available from the guidance counselor at Chipley High School or Vernon High School, or can be requested at the address above.
- Final documentation of enrollment at a post-secondary institution **must** be a letter from the institution's registrar's office. Copies of a student's schedule is **not** sufficient.
- The awarding of Trust funds will be based on the total number of points acquired at Chipley High School or Vernon High School in grades 9-12.
- The maximum number of points that can be acquired in a regular school year is 53.

Grades	36 points
Attendance	4 points
Workshops	4 points
Community Service	5 points
Tests	4 points
- The maximum number of points that can be acquired in summer school is 12 points (2 credits).
- Only one elective course will be awarded points per school year.
- A student/parent cannot add, delete, or change any information from a previous school year.
- An appointed committee reviews all documentation received.
- All documents must be **postmarked on or before June 15th of each year.**
